Tuition Assistance Released

Parents, last week the state released the income guidelines for the School Choice Program. The School Choice Program is a tuition assistance program offered by the state for our students enrolled in our Kindergarten through 8th grade. The School Choice Program can offer anywhere from \$500.00 off tuition to totally covering all tuition and fees. This program even continues into high school. We encourage ALL families to look at their 2021 tax return to see if you qualify. You are looking at the adjusted gross income line. Listed below is the guidelines chart. If you think you might qualify please or have any questions please contact Mrs. Scheu. If your family does not qualify for these income based options and are still interested in learning about additional tuition assistance options please contact Mrs. Scheu for information on our parish scholarships.

Registration Opens: Wednesday, February 23 @ 6pm

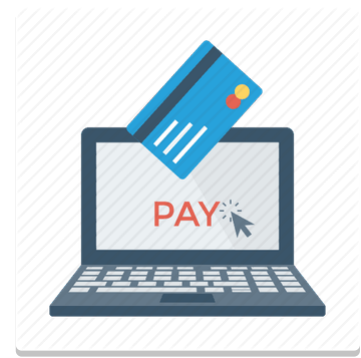

Lastly, TEENPOWER registration fees will continue to be in a tiered payment structure for both conferences. Our hope is to make TEENPOWER as affordable as possible, as we know that families have differing abilities to pay. The three options are based on an honor system by which we trust each family to choose the rate they are able to pay. There are also scholarship opportunities through the Scooter Scholarship for partial to full financial assistance.
