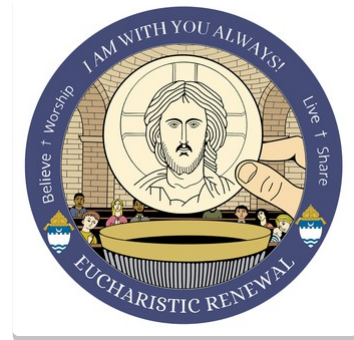

The third graders are collecting personal hygiene items to meet the needs of the families staying at the **Ozanam Family Shelter** in Evansville.

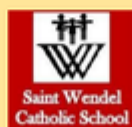


The Ozanam is in need of Personal Hygiene Items such as:

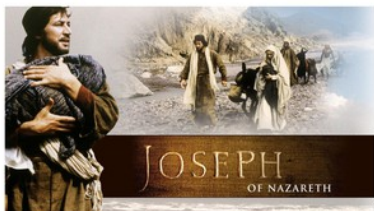

Math Contest at USI

The University of Southern Indiana is one of the host sites for the 2023 Indiana State Mathematics Contest. I would like to personally invite you and your students to participate in the contest on Saturday, April 22nd to be held on our beautiful campus. The contest is open to any student in Upper Elementary, Middle/Junior High and High School. A participant may take only one test each year in one of these categories: Pre-Algebra, Algebra First Course/Integrated Math I,



Geometry/Integrated Math II, Algebra Second Course/Integrated Math III, or Comprehensive. There is a non-refundable \$7.00 participant fee for each student. Registration is now open and will be through March 31. Parents or guardians will be asked to register their students for the contest, with the understanding that ICTM will ask for each child's math teacher's name and email address to verify registration status. Host sites will recognize local top performers in each exam category (1st, 2nd, 3rd places and top 25%). After all scores in the state are processed, the 1st, 2nd, 3rd place and top 5% state performers in each exam category will be recognized at the ICTM Outstanding Scholars Award Ceremony at the Indiana Statehouse in June.

At USI, the day begins at 9:00 am with registration followed by the exam from 9:30 to 11:00 local time. Following the exam, we have a fast-paced competition called Math-O-Rama. During this event, students solve problems while working in pairs; after each round, partners change. The competition is both fun and challenging. Continuing our local tradition, we will recognize, for each of the five testing categories, the top student at each school with the highest combined state score and Math-O-Rama score. At the completion of Math-O-Rama, students are treated to a pizza lunch, compliments of the USI math faculty. The day ends with an awards ceremony.
