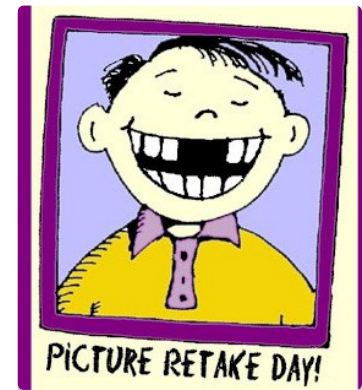
## Saint Wendel PTO Turtle Fundraiser- Cancelled

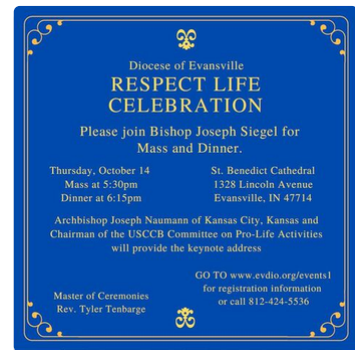


### Saint Wendel Cafeteria Worker Needed
