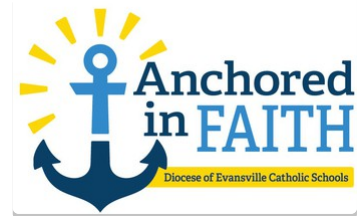

JESUS AND THE EUCHARIST STUDY

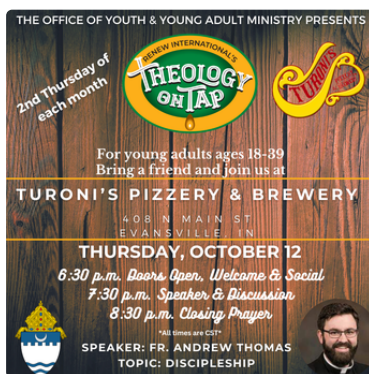
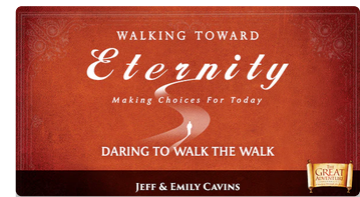
Do you struggle believing in Jesus's True Presence in the Eucharist?

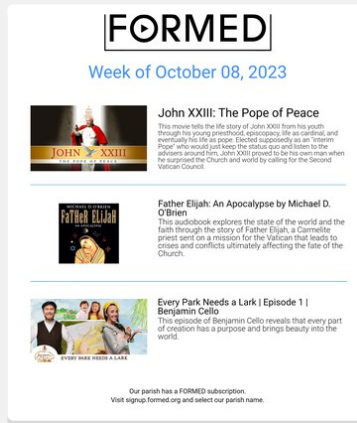

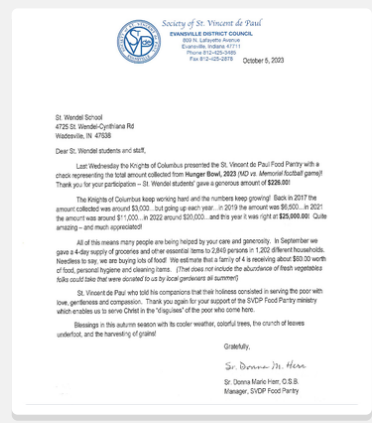
