

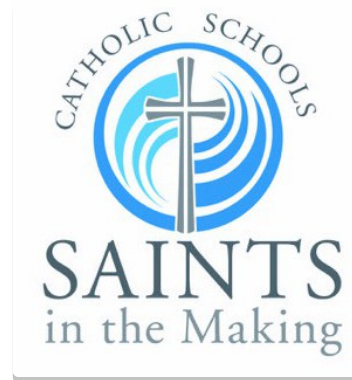
Saint Wendel Newsletter

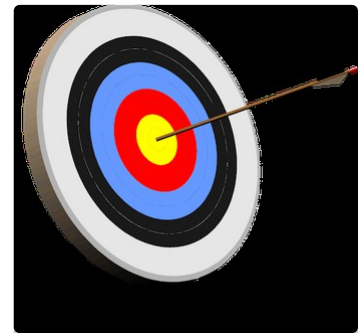


Saint Wendel King and Queen Awarded Runner Up!

Thank you so much for your collection of **\$190.00** (Check # 26302, written on September 9) to the St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry as part of the 2021 Mater Dei vs. Memorial football **Hunger Bowl** collection. It was a great success!

We are grateful to the **Knights of Columbus** for organizing and promoting this yearly event. Last Wednesday evening some members of the **K of C** along with several principals came to the pantry and presented the money collected from the various entities – the total was **\$11,061.99. Amazing!**

In the first annual (2017) Mater Dei vs. Memorial football **Hunger Bowl** game the amount raised for the St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry was about \$3,000.00. 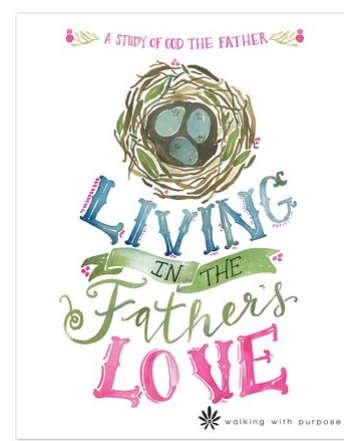
Men's Club Burgoo

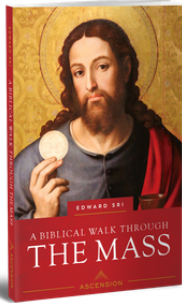
