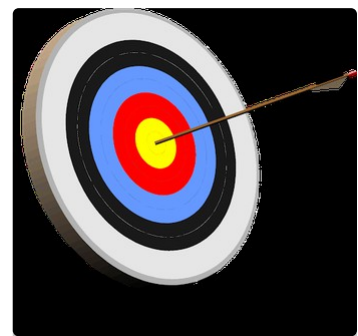

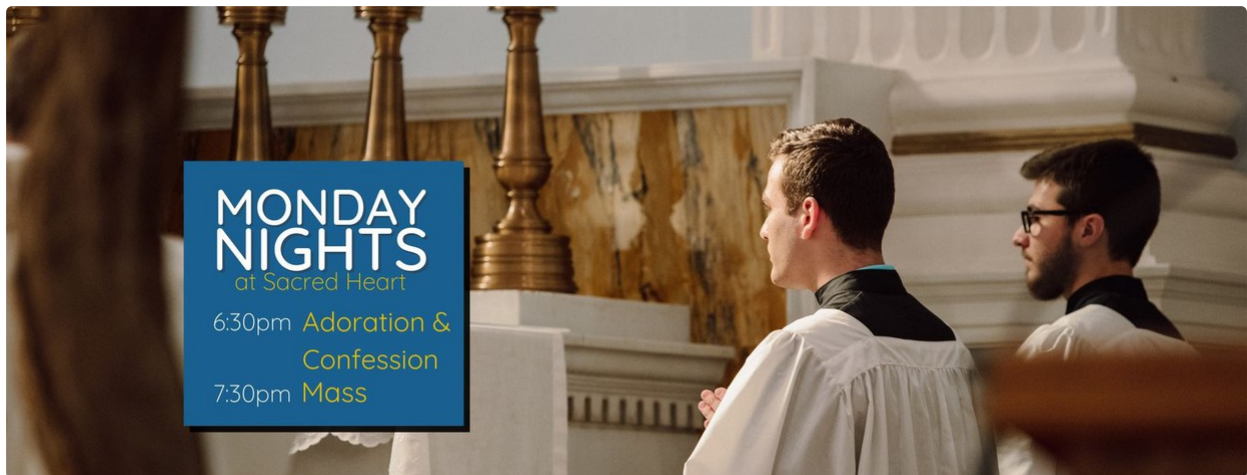
Online Giving

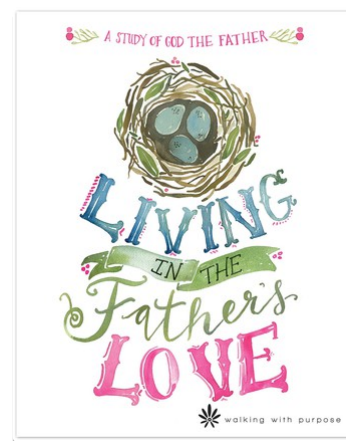

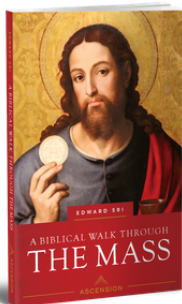
