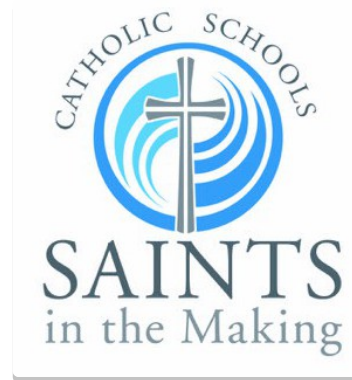


# Saint Wendel Newsletter

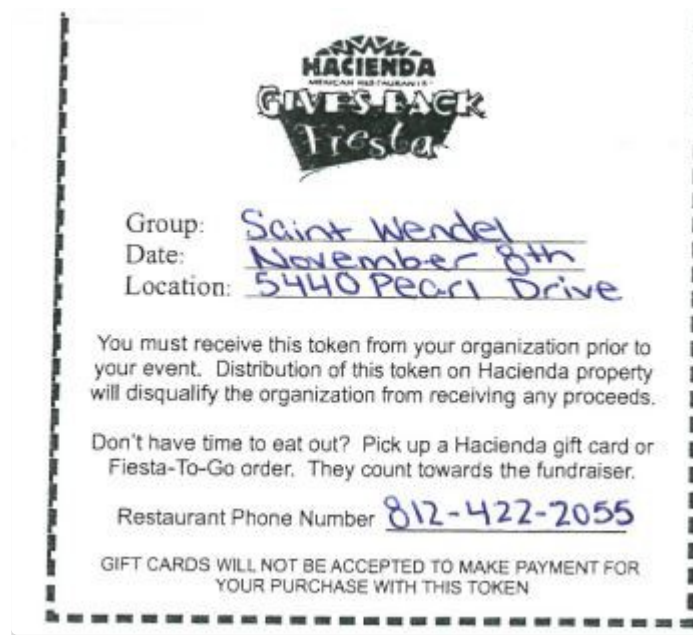

### *Saint Wendel SGO Donations Needed*

Saint Wendel has been very fortunate that the school choice expansion has opened the door for so many more of our families. In order to receive a school choice voucher students must have a "pathway" onto the program. Over 90% of our students use the SGO pathway. This means that in their first year at Saint Wendel they receive a \$500 scholarship and then after that they can apply the following year for a school choice voucher. Many times the school choice voucher will cover all of the tuition and fees for the student.

**Saint Wendel this year has to raise \$21,850 to cover all our SGO's. We have already raised \$14,971. We still need \$6,879 to reach our goal!**

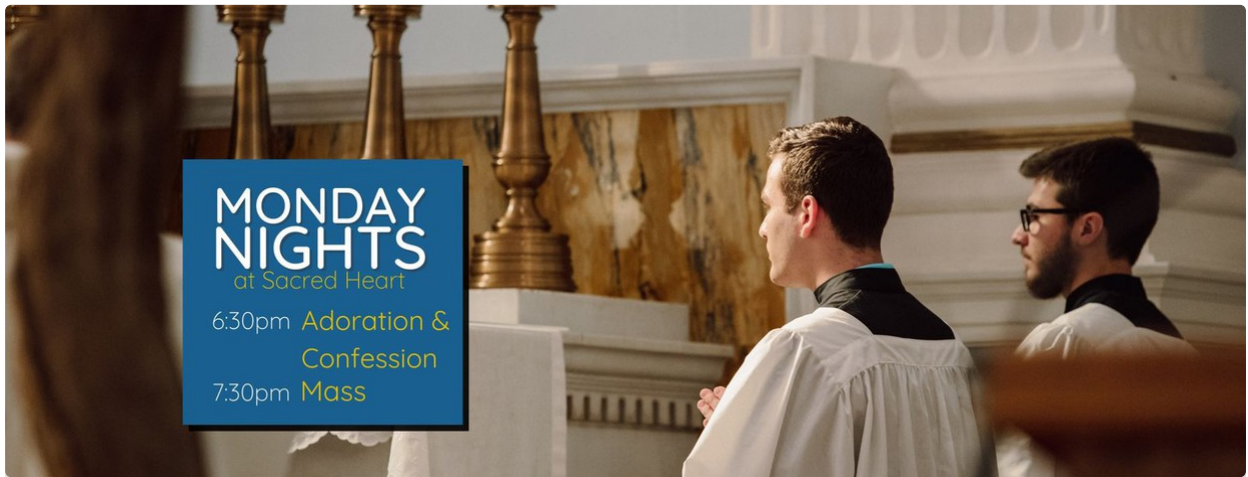

## Get vaccinated! Pfizer vaccine approved for children ages 5-11

### The Pfizer vaccine will help keep you safe.

The FDA has issued an extension of the Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) allowing use of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine to prevent COVID-19 in individuals 5 years of age and older. COVID-19 vaccine can be given at the same time as other routine vaccinations.



### COVID-19 vaccination is an important tool to help us get back to normal.

The vaccines teach our bodies how to recognize and fight the virus that causes COVID-19. COVID-19 vaccines are safe and effective at preventing COVID-19, including severe illness and death. Fully vaccinated is defined as two weeks past your second dose of the Pfizer vaccine.



### Play sports!

No more missing games, practices or other extra-curriculars! You won't be sidelined from your favorite activities if you are fully vaccinated, so long as you don't develop symptoms.



### Go to school!

If you are fully vaccinated you won't have to miss important lessons or tests to quarantine if you're a close contact of someone with COVID-19 as long as you remain symptom-free. You just need to get tested 5-7 days after an exposure and wear a mask indoors for 14 days.

### What changes once you are fully vaccinated:

- ✓ If you've been around someone who has COVID-19, you do not need to quarantine as long as you remain symptom-free. You just need to get tested 5-7 days after an exposure and wear a mask indoors for 14 days.
- ✓ You don't need to wear a mask as outlined by the CDC, except in select state government facilities, COVID-19 testing and vaccination sites, and as required by local authorities, healthcare facilities and schools.
- ✓ If you travel in the United States, you do not need to get tested before or after travel or self-quarantine after travel.

Experts are still researching things like how long the protection from the vaccine lasts and will update the guidance for vaccinated people as we get new information.

### Prevent COVID-19

Children can get sick with COVID-19 and spread the virus to others, even if they don't have symptoms. Most children with COVID-19 have mild symptoms or have no symptoms at all. However, some children can get severely ill from COVID-19. They might require hospitalization, intensive care, or a ventilator to help them breathe. In rare cases, they might die. Experts are also investigating a rare but serious medical condition associated with COVID-19 in children called Multisystem Inflammatory Syndrome in Children (MIS-C). The National Institutes of Health estimate that 11-15% of children infected with COVID-19 develop long-term symptoms.
