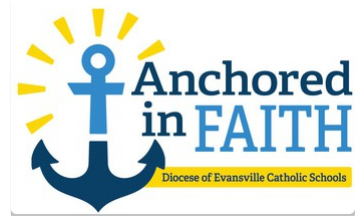


Saint Wendel Catholic School

Dear Students, Parents, Faculty and Staff of St. Wendel School,

Creetings in our Lord Jesus Christ!

As you know, St. Wendel School has the mission to form students in a holistic way. We strive for academic excellence, anchored in our Catholic faith, and provide opportunities for character development through the school curriculum and various extracurricular activities. One opportunity for such personal and social growth is your sports programs. Knowing how seriously we can become involved in athletics, I share the following reflections for all of us, athletes and spectators, to give the best of ourselves and to witness to Christ through our participation in these events.

Sports are a tremendous way young people can realize their potential, share in teamwork, grow in maturity and foster lasting friendships. They are an opportunity for youth to give the very best of themselves toward a higher purpose. In this way, sports provide a mirror to the life of faith in which we are called, as St. Paul said, to fight the good fight, finish the race and keep the faith (1 Cor. 9:24-27).

Sports also provide an opportunity for those supporting athletes, encouraging them to give all they can for their team and building school spirit. In this way, we too as fans need to give the best of ourselves. We need to offer our encouragement for their efforts, fitting praise in their success and proper consolation in defeat. All of these circumstances provide an opportunity for growth that help young people to learn and mature into adulthood. Again, sports provide a mirror, allowing us to see how we can also encourage, praise and console young people as they grow in faith and become faithful disciples of Jesus Christ.

There is another level of sportsmanship that deserves our attention. Our faith is never detached from the witness we offer to others. Anytime our Catholic sports teams compete, it is an opportunity to witness to what I have said above: that sport mirror faith and are an opportunity to give the best of ourselves. It not only creates scandal when Catholic Christians say and do things that are inappropriate, but perhaps more importantly, we miss a precious opportunity to witness our faith in a way that is so accessible to others: simply by showing respect and common decency to all others, whether those on our team or on the opposing team.

To players and fans alike, I urge you: Give the best of yourselves! Compete and do not cheat. Cheer and do not demean. Support and do not slander. Give the best of yourselves so that we and our Catholic community can help foster a community of encouragement and be a place where competition is a source of growth and maturity, not of fear. Christ is calling us to discipleship in every place and in every circumstance. Through our sporting activities, let us witness to Him in the gym, on the field and on the court so that He will be made known by the best that we have given.

Please be assured that you are remembered in my daily prayers, especially at Mass, and I ask for remembrance in yours. Through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, our Diocesan Patroness, and St. Sebastian, patron of athletes, may God continue to bless and guide you, forming you ever more deeply into the image of Jesus.
