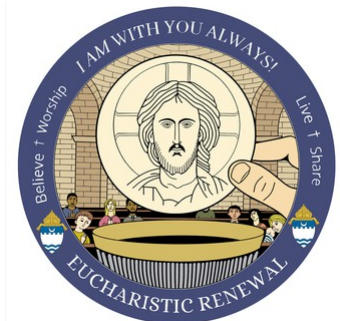


Saint Wendel Catholic School

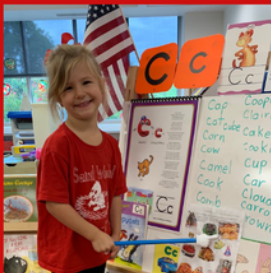
