Now use your square tiles and complete "Math Area Sheet 1". How many squares fill up each rectangle? Write it down on the paper.

Next, Do the "Math Area" sheet (sent home). Go to Google Classroom and click Monday Area. Type in the answers of the area in square units for each of the 6 shapes.

Optional: On the back of the area sheet that you completed, you may play the game for extra practice called "Toss it, Draw it, Total it". Students need dice and their grid paper. Students will roll the dice twice to find the number of rows and columns. If they roll a 2 and 3, they will make a rectangle out of 2 row sand 3 columns. Students color it in and label the area in square units.

You may play on Math Prodigy if you like for a few minutes too.

Last, count the total number of square units to find the winner.
