Many Thanks - to those who recently made contributions to the endowments at the Community Foundation of Posey County which are designated to benefit Holy Angels Church. Over the past three weeks a total of \$49,000 was contributed to the endowments which are designated to provide long-term support of Holy Angels Church in perpetuity. In celebration of their 30-year anniversary the Community Foundation of Posey County matched those contributions with \$49,000. This is a total of \$98,000 which has been placed in endowments which will assist in the preservation of Holy Angels Church by providing funding for utilities, property and liability insurance, and for maintenance and improvements to the building.
