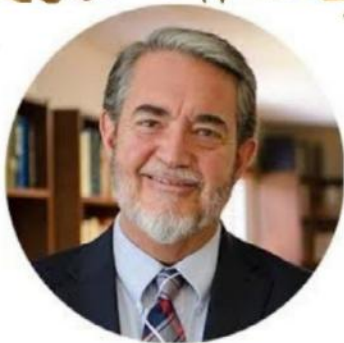

Qualifications for a Pastoral Council Member:

- Person is a registered member of the parish
- Person is baptized and confirmed Catholic
- Person regularly attends Sunday Mass in the parish
- Person supports and enables parish life
- Person participates in the life of the parish
- Person of prayer trying to understand and live God’s will

This year we will once again use a selection process that removes the popularity component of an election. In this process there is no public exposure as a candidate. This process is modeled after the selection process used in the Cathedral of Saint John the Evangelist Parish in the Diocese of Cleveland and is rooted in the biblical selection of Judas’ replacement in the Acts of the Apostles – by the casting of lots. In choosing the replacement for Judas the other disciples found two worthy candidates. They made their selection between the two by casting lots.

Selection Process

- Announcement in the bulletin – “Call for Nominations”
- Nomination can be made by the interested person or be submitted by others. (Any parish member may nominate anyone with the above listed qualifications for the pastoral council. This is where the participation by the parish members enters the process.)
- Candidates nominated will be notified by the pastor and any questions answered.
- Candidates who accept the nomination for pastoral council will have their names submitted for selection.
- The new members will then be selected by casting lots (names will be placed in a basket and drawn).
