In this painting, Mary relies on Joseph for support, both physically and emotionally. Joseph walks boldly and steadfastly. Internally, however, he may be full of fears and anxieties of his own. Both of them show their resilience, their trust in God, and the loving support they have for each other.

In this painting there are two favorite moments for me. The first one is Mary's hand on Joseph's shoulder. It's such a sweet moment that brings both of them together in a very loving way. The other moment is the blowing wind. The wind not only alludes to the harsh adversity of their experience, but it also hints at the presence of the Holy Spirit as they journey together."
